PRIVACY STATEMENT SYSTEMEC

Systemec B.V. respects the privacy of visitors to its website and ensures that the personal information you provide to us is treated confidentially. Personal data are processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (henceforth 'GDPR').

The website www.systemec.nl and the internet services linked to it are made available to you by Systemec B.V. (henceforth 'Systemec'), with its registered office in Venlo and registered in the trade register of the Chamber of Commerce Limburg under number 12027782. Systemec guarantees, as far as possible, the protection of the privacy of all visitors to the site. This means that we also require maximum effort from our partners in monitoring your personal data.

Security

The processing of personal data is subject to special legal requirements. When Systemec processes personal data of yours, Systemec will comply with the applicable laws and regulations, including the GDPR. Systemec takes security measures to limit misuse of and unauthorised access to personal data. Systemec's services are ISO 27001 and NEN 7510 certified.

Purposes

In order to provide its services and reach (future) customers, Systemec needs personal data.

Legal bases

Systemec hereby complies with the legal bases, Article 6 GDPR.

Execution of the (main) agreement:

- Provision of a service, including the needs and wishes of the customer relationship, to customisation of a service.

Legal obligations:

- In the context of compliance with laws and regulations, for handling disputes and having conduct financial audits, for example.

Legitimate interest:

- The conclusion of the (main) agreement;
- The compilation of management information, as well as for determining strategy;
- For the purpose of product and service development;
- Conducting market research;
- Because of information provision, with the sending of a newsletter, user information as an example;
- A service message or other electronic message;
- To make a targeted offer, for example by telephone or e-mail;
- To analyse, maintain, optimise and secure the use of a website, including the associated technology, partly to prevent abuse and fraud;
- Due to exchange of personal data between the various companies active in the Systemec Group. The personal data may, for example, be combined with other data collected in connection with the use of our products or services (and/or products or services of other group companies). This data allows us

to create a corporate customer profile. This allows us to better serve customers and better tailor our products and services to their needs and wishes.

Based on consent:

- Sending a newsletter. After you have given your consent, you will receive our newsletter. Should you no longer wish to receive it, you can simply unsubscribe. You will then no longer receive our newsletter.

Processing of your personal data

Systemec processes your personal data. Systemec uses these personal data for the performance of the relevant agreement, for its other services and to keep you informed as a (future) customer of (new) products and services of Systemec, of companies cooperating in a group with it or of carefully selected third parties. In doing so, Systemec takes your preferences into account. If you do not wish to receive information about (new) products and services, you can simply report this to us. We will then no longer send you any information.

The personal data we process:

- Name and address details;
- Gender;
- Telephone numbers;
- Email addresses;
- IP addresses;
- Bank account numbers;
- Other personal data that you actively provide (in writing or orally).

Your rights

You have the following rights:

- The right to know whether and what personal data about you is being processed;
- The right to inspect and copy those data (insofar as the privacy of another is not compromised thereby);
- The right to correction, addition or deletion of data if necessary
- The right to request (partial) destruction of your data. This can only be complied with if the data do not have to be retained on the basis of a statutory regulation be retained;
- The right to oppose the processing of your data in certain cases.

Camera surveillance

To protect the interests of our goods, employees and customers, we use camera surveillance in our car parks, the entrances to our sites and in public areas. For more information, please refer to the camera protocol. This protocol can be requested from the security manager at security@systemec.nl.

Cookies

Retention period

Systemec does not retain your personal data longer than strictly necessary to realise the purposes for which your data are collected. We delete personal data when it is no longer needed and in any case after expiry of the maximum retention period applicable under applicable law.

Provision to third parties

Systemec will not share personal data with third parties except in one of the following circumstances:

- When you authorise Systemec to do so;
- In order to supply personal data to partners or other trusted companies of Systemec so that they can process the data. Systemec has concluded processing agreements with these parties to protect your data as well as possible;
- In case of a court order or legal obligation or to comply with applicable laws and regulations.
